Below are Important Notes That Must be Taken into Consideration

- Raising our student's awareness with the importance of following the social distance and the safety precautions from infectious diseases.
- Every student MUST come to school with his/her own hand gel or sanitizer, tissues and wipes.
- Sharing any items/materials between students are totally forbidden. "NO SHARING POLICY" is enforced.
- Parents must confirm that their children are free of Covid symptoms and are in good health before they get on the school bus or enter school campus.
- It is obligatory that a parent/guardian notifies the school if the child has had infection with any infectious diseases or a positive COVID-19 diagnosis and/or has been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
 - KG 1 students have to arrive the first day by their parents, as no morning bus service will be operated the first day for bus subscribers, and it will operate at the dismissal of the first day.





Preparing for Back to School

- Share the above protocols with your children.
- Support the schools' decisions in front of your children, so that they feel positive about the return to school albeit under unusual circumstances.
- Teach your children the importance of maintaining distance between themselves and others, discouraging touching including hugs and handshakes.
- Teach your children the importance of proper hand washing and frequent use of hand gels and soaps.
- Get vaccinated and ask extended family members to do the same.

Educational Process for the Academic Year 2022-2023

Our plan for the new academic year will basically depend on a blended learning process and the "Flipped Classroom" approach, based on "Bloom's Classification Models" to boost students' thinking and perception skills. This is will be depending on recorded videos prepared and presented by our distinguished teachers, which will be uploaded on our school platform – COLNN; to be discussed in class with the students to reach the required thinking and perception skills.

As for the educational process, it will include face to face education and online sessions (if needed, according to the school academic vision, or any uncounted circumstances).

Important Notes for Parents and Students

- All surfaces (like door handles, stair railings, ... etc.) and classes will be sanitized regularly. As for the toilets, they will be cleaned and sanitized continuously.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch boxes and water flasks, as it is not permitted to share food nor water with their colleagues. Also, consideration must be given for choosing healthy and wholesome food to raise the immunity system.
- Indicative prevention signs will be widespread along the school to raise health awareness.
- Bringing liquid alcohol for sanitizing with the students, is forbidden for their safety.
- We assure you that there are no changes in the school uniform, and that you can find it at the points of sale which were mentioned before. Note that it is totally forbidden to attend the school day out of uniform.
- Vaccination is an effective mean to protect from COVID-19 and an important part of safely getting back to normal life, as getting vaccinated reduces the risk of infection.

Notes: We call upon parents to fully cooperate with us and deal transparently and not to hide any information or symptoms the student has, and the necessity to assume responsibility towards their children and all students and school personnel as the first priority is to preserve the health and safety of our children and employees.





Attending and Departure Times Regulations

- Two extra gates are opened (gate 2 and 5) to facilitate students entering and exiting, and decreasing the crowding.
- Sticking to the departure timings mentioned below is a must, as the student will not be allowed to stay at school after **02:45 PM** or join it before **06:40 AM**, and your commitment to these times is appreciated and respected, to ensure the safety of our children, as there will be no supervision before or after these timings.
- Morning line begins at 06:50 AM, and students' attendance before 06:40 AM is not allowed.
- The school day will end at 02:15 PM for all students except kindergarteners, and the gates will open at 02:20 PM for non-bus subscribers.
- The departure of bus subscribers will be through their gathering and exiting directly from the gates designated for them, under the school members supervision.
- The departure of non-bus subscribers' kindergarten students will be from **01:45 PM** until **02:00 PM**, after that period the school gates will be closed in preparation for the rest of the students to dismiss safely. In case that, the parent/guardian was not able to pick up the students during that period, he will have to wait and pick them up with the rest of the students of the other stages at **02:20 PM**.
- For the safety and security of our children, none of the parents, private drivers, or private bus matrons will be allowed to enter the school campus. Rather, receiving the students will be through the security members at the gates by calling them with loudspeakers.





Important Notes:

- Two ID Cards will be issued to kindergarteners. One of them must be worn daily by the student when attending school, especially within the first day and within the first month of school, as well as during the school trips. As for the other ID Card, it is for the non-bus subscribers, and it must be shown daily by the adult who picks up the child from school throughout the school year, knowing that children are not allowed to be handed over to their siblings at school except to those who are in the preparatory stage and up, and showing the ID Card is also a MUST. As for first and second primary, they will receive only an ID Card to be used for picking them up under the same conditions.
- It is not permitted for the student to leave during the school day, except in emergency cases and not on frequent bases, in order to ensure the regularity of the educational process and in implementation with the decisions of the Ministry of Education. Leaving in this case, should be maximum at 01:15 PM and that must be by the presence of the parent/guardian along with having a previous permission from the stage headmaster/mistress.





Note: Please take into consideration that parking MUST be for a period that does not exceed a few minutes, and within the first two traffic lanes parallel to the school, as the lack of compliance by some led to the disruption of traffic, which prompted the Traffic Department to inform us that the penalty for violating the waiting area has been stressed and applied decisively, which may amount to the withdrawal of cars.







Official Communication Channels

We at NLS believe that **COMMUNICATION** is the key to success. So, if you have any inquiries or complaints, we are here and glad to receive it through our official communication channels – (**note that no complaints are to be considered through any other means**).

- You can send any messages or inquiries through the message board on the schools' platform COLNN, as it is the simplest and fastest official way to contact teachers and school's administration, and replying will be within 24 Hours, except for Thursdays will be within 48 Hours.
- Parents/guardians of kindergarten, first and second primary students can send written messages in the Students' NLS Planner, as it is mandatory to bring it daily to school and checking it at home for being an official communication channel. We encourage you to spend some time with your child while going through the NLS Planner discussing together the various info embedded within to help your child in building a broad-minded personality and developing many skills through different enjoyable methods while spending a delightful learning time for the child with his/ her parents.
- Parents Services Center at the school, is honoured to welcome you daily in case of having any complaints, requests or inquiries and that is during the working hours from 07:00 AM to 01:30 PM, as it will not be permitted to enter except at those times, with the importance of wearing a face mask.
